Francis Marion University in Florence, SC, Features Works by Elaine Quave and Neva Campbell

Ceramic sculptures by Greenville artist Elaine Quave and paintings by Myrtle Beach artist Neva Campbell will be on view in the Adele Kassab Gallery in the Hyman Fine Arts Center at Francis Marion University from Jan. 9 through Feb. 15, 2018. A reception will held on Jan. 12, from 6-8pm.

Both Quave and Campbell explore the natural world and our place within that world.

Quave states: "My ceramic sculptures evoke a garden, one reminiscent of a bleached coral reef in which the reflection of our own human nature is both terrifying and beautiful at the same time. Porcelain bones are arranged to resemble plants, each implying their own unique stories of our personal interactions with them."

Campbell's series of works include insects, bones, sea creatures, and the human figure. She describes herself as "a modern impressionist using bright colors to convey emotional light and density" she finds inspiration in the South's dark history,

Quave received her MFA at the Tyler School of Art, Temple University and is also a graduate of the SC Governor's School for the Arts and Humanities, where she currently serves as an instructor.

Campbell is a graduate of the Art Institute of Atlanta and has worked as a graphic designer. She has returned to her native Myrtle Beach where she was named Best Artist for the 2016 Grand Strand Happening List, and has exhibited in Artfields three times.

Wang is an artist renowned for her ability to capture the radiance of nature in her exuberant expressionist painting where color and the touch of her paint brush infuse a sense of radiant vitality. Throughout the human history, virtually every culture has worshiped or honored the Sun. It is the artist's wish is to remind us today again of our everlasting quest to celebrate life and protect nature with our glorious and radiant sun.

With many exhibitions to her credit, Wang has been an exhibiting painter since her 1985 exhibit at the Gallery 91 Show, Soho, New York and most recently Shen Chang Art Gallery, Hangzhou, China in 2015. She has won numerous awards for her painting, most notably the Featured Artist Vistas Award in 2004 and 2005 at the NC Museum of Natural Sciences in Raleigh.

While always involved in her creative expressionist painting, since the 80's she has worked corporately as a designer and marketer for Sony Ericsson, Family Health International and Black and Decker. Most

recently she owned and operated the Grace Li Wang Gallery in collaboration with international art dealers, galleries and clients with focus on the US, China, and Europe markets.

Wang graduated with both a Bachelor of Environmental Design in Visual Design and Graduate studies from NC State University, School of Design, Raleigh, NC, 1974 and in 1970 had majored in painting at the NC Governor's School at Salem College, Winston Salem, NC.
