Charleston Artist Guild in Charleston, SC, Offers Works by Ginny Paternite

The Charleston Artist Guild in Charleston, SC, will present *The Color of Light*, featuring works by Ginny Paternite, on view in the Guild Gallery, from Dec. 2 - 31, 2016. A reception will be held on Dec. 2, from 5-8pm.

Paternite will present a collection of paintings featuring scenes from the low country highlighting how she is able to capture the warmth and light that falls upon her subjects. She has also created several special Christmas paintings for the exhibit.

Raised in upstate New York, Paternite watched her dad paint and often served as his model when he needed to see a particular gesture or expression. The aroma of oil paint, linseed and turps is forever etched in her childhood memories. She attended art school at her dad's urging, but eventually found herself with a masters degree in social studies education and spent the bulk of her career teaching American history. Full-time teaching and raising three children left little time for painting.

Paternite and her husband retired to the beauty and warmth of Charleston, SC, in 2011 and with her newfound free time has immersed herself in painting. She has taken many art workshops in Charleston and her goal is to keep painting and learning, and then painting some more!

Paternite can't explain what motivates her and states, "I go to bed thinking about the painting I'm working on and how I can improve it, and I get up in the

morning eager to get back to it, and then I can't wait to start a new one. Painting is my passion, my therapy, and my path to self-actualization. Maybe it's because I had to suppress my desire to paint for so many years when I was teaching history and raising a family, that now I can't get enough of it!"
