Society of Bluffton Artists in Bluffton, SC, Features Works by Local High School Students

The Society of Bluffton Artists (SOBA) in Bluffton, SC, will feature the artwork of local students in their *Annual High School Art Show*, on view from Feb. 6 through Mar. 5, 2023. A reception will be held on Feb. 11, from 5-7pm.

This year, three schools are participating in the student art exhibit: Bluffton High School, May River High School and Cross School. High school students involved in their schools' arts programs often go on to pursue careers in art, design or photography.

"SOBA is committed to its mission of providing art education and art appreciation to the local community," said Cynthia Van Nus, SOBA event organizer. "The art show gives students a chance for public recognition for their talents and achievements, the same that is given to student athletes, science projects and music concerts."

John Cullinen, Arts Teacher at Cross Upper School, said Cross School has a growing art program that infuses traditional mediums with digital art and photography - a sampling of which will be shown in SOBA's upcoming show.




