Ella Richardson Fine Art in Charleston, SC, will present *Charleston: Spires and Light*, featuring works by Donald Weber, on view from Mar. 4 - 31, 2022. The exhibition opens Mar. 4, with a gallery open house from 10am-8pm. The open house continues Mar. 5, 10am-5pm, and the artist will give a painting demonstration in the gallery 2-4pm.

Donald Weber's art education began with his study of architecture, evidenced in his sure strokes delineating the streets and skylines of Charleston. Soaring steeples and narrow streets bounded by the reach of sun or blanket of dusk, palms and planters, stucco and brick - these are the elements that beckon exploration and for Weber, expression. The paintings are a paean to Charleston.

An American artist, Weber paints in a contemporary impressionist style. His mediums include oil, oil pastel and pastel. He draws daily with graphite and charcoal. Weber earned a Bachelors of Architecture degree from the University of Kentucky and is now a retired licensed architect whose career in the entertainment industry included clients such as Paramount, Nickelodeon, Warner Brothers, NASA, SeaWorld, Crayola and KSL resorts such as Squaw Valley Ski Resort and The Hotel

"The expectations demanded from that level of international brands set my design and technical skills bar pretty high," he said, "and that drive for quality has definitely transferred over to my fine arts pursuits," said Weber.

Weber has continued his art education through self-teaching and workshops with noted artists such as Scott Burdick and Kim English. Mentors are many but some favorites include artists C.W. Mundy, Irby Brown and Masters Ilya Repin, Joaquin Sorolla, J.M.W. Turner, John Singer Sargent and Edgar Degas.

Weber and his wife Debra now make their home in Louisville, KY, but also lived in Santa Fe, NM, for 11 years. They still visit frequently in their Airstream. "I love the diversity between New Mexico and Kentucky," said Weber. "The cultures, the weather and the landscapes are so different. Each time I return to each location I am re-energized about painting what is there."

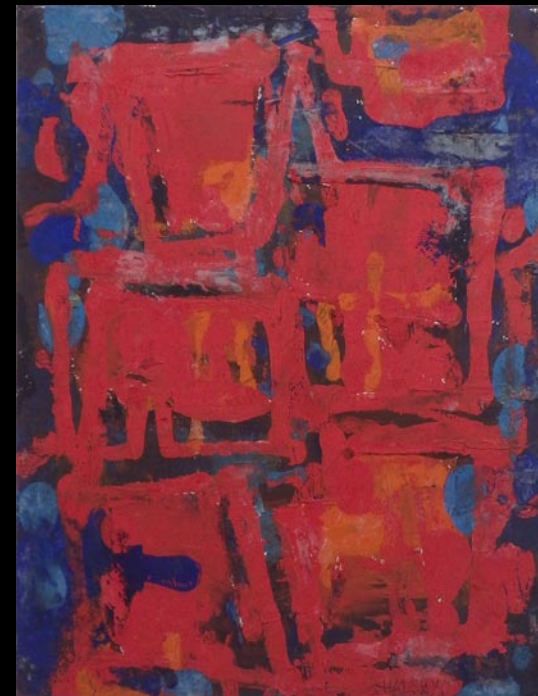

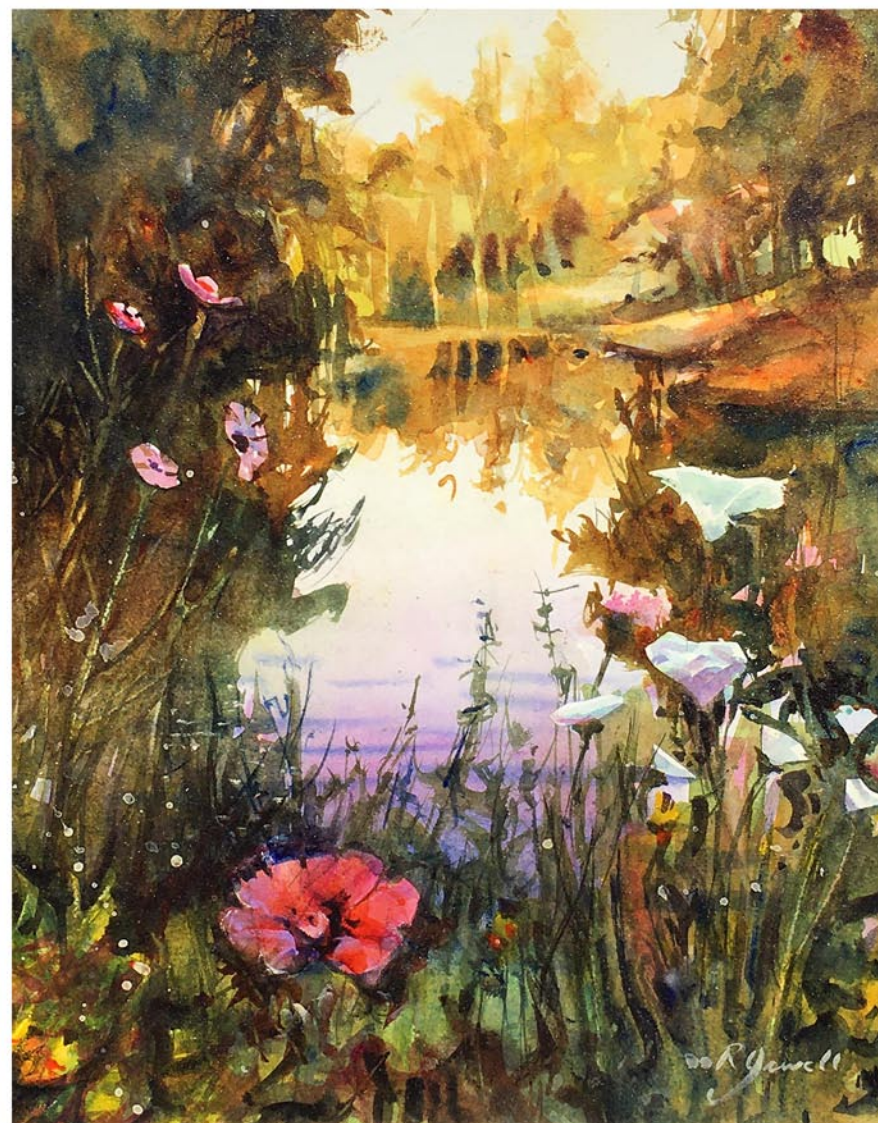
