For the past fifteen years, Mike Basher has traveled the globe photographing campaigns for large corporations such as Under Armour, Reebok and The North Face, working with celebrities and athletes like Michael Phelps, Lindsey Vonn, and Andy Murray. Working exclusively with large format black and white film, each image is carefully crafted—seen through the process of making a precise exposure, hand developing the negative, final printing and display.
